- Front driver side CV joint, oil pan gasket (Oct 2019)
- Fuel pump, fuel lines, fuel filter, fuel pressure regulator, all 6 fuel injectors (Oct 2019)
- Rear drums resurfaced, shoes replaced (June 2019)
- Timing belt, water pump, radiator hoses, thermostat, associated gaskets (June 2019)
